

SB 236 Pharmacy Practice Amendments as amended (Sen. Vickers)

Anticipated Fiscal Impact for State:

Summary

SB 236 affects multiple areas of prescription drug dispensing. We do not expect fiscal impact from changes associated with insulin dispensing. The bill language does not require a health plan to cover additional days of insulin, nor does it require coverage for dispensing antibiotics for sexually transmitted disease from a Department of Health clinic or allowing hospital pharmacies to dispense selected prescriptions. In addition, we anticipate the bill will continue to produce a savings of \$8,795 per year by clarifying the ability to return some prescription drugs to the pharmacy.
